Program Description

The Peak Academic Tune-Up program is a 15-hour preparation course to improve students' organization & focus for the upcoming school year. Whether your student is preparing to transition into middle school, high school or enter college, the Peak Academic Tune-Up programs are designed to create a system for students to effectively prepare for the upcoming school year as well as become aware of what will be expected of them. While this program is designed to enhance skills necessary for all subjects, there will be opportunities to focus on specific math/science subject matter, or humanities subject matter, depending on the students' needs.

Activities/Process

This is a summer program designed for small groups divided into the following grade levels:

- “Middle Schoolers” for students going into the 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th grades
- “Underclass” for students going into the 9th or 10th grades
- “Upperclass” for students going into the 11th or 12th grades, or those who are college-bound

Each group is introduced to a basic method of organizing information (visual, verbal & written), trained how to take information rich, detail oriented notes, and offered time management guidelines that can help improve their overall academic proficiency & accountability. By encouraging the use of our organizational method and using active time management skills, students prepare themselves for greater success on quizzes, tests and major assignments.

Outcomes

- Develop reliable organizational and study skills
- Create relevant & information rich note taking skills
- Inspire independence by managing time effectively
- Cultivate self-motivated and self-reliant students

Evaluation

Each student will receive an evaluation of progress made, as well as strengths and weaknesses to be addressed. This course includes approximately 1-2 hours for a one-on-one review of this evaluation with both the student and his/her parents. Strategies for future success, specific to the upcoming school year, will also be presented in this evaluative process.
